S'Klallam Days Royalty Ceremony Rules and Regulations

All Contestants must:

- A. Live on the Port Gamble S'Klallam reservation or be enrolled a Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribal member.
- B. Be enrolled in an education program, unless they have already completed high school.
- C. Be active in attending Port Gamble S'Klallam community functions.
- D. Be willing to speak about our Tribe in a clear voice at Public or Community events.
- E. Be willing to travel to Schools and Local Tribal Events such as, Canoe Journey, Pow-Wows, Parades and other appropriate events representing the Tribe. If for some reason the Princess/Warrior is unable to attend a requested event, the Runner-up will be asked to attend in their place.
- F. Attend pre-pageant practices, meetings and events.
- G. Agree to represent as a positive role model at all times and uphold community values with respect and honor. Make best effort to dress in regalia or semi-formal/formal clothing with sash and crown.
- H. Be willing to act as a welcoming Hostess/Host when requested to do so for community events.

Other Rules:

1. Royalty will be disqualified if he/she is unable to fulfill his/her duties, either through non-attendance at Tribal events or is an inappropriate role model representing the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe. The Runner-up will then become Royalty.

Definition of an inappropriate role model: smokes tobacco, uses a vaporizer, marijuana or use of any other illegal drug, drinks alcohol, does not attend education program on a regular basis, is involved in court or convicted of any crime or is disrespectful to others.

The decision to disqualify or take disciplinary action will be made at the discretion of the pageant coordinators of the Youth and Culture Departments. A decision must be based on fact (such as suspension in school or an actual conviction), not hear say. A Princess or Warrior may choose to relinquish their crown if necessary. The Runner-up will be asked to finish out the term.

2. The current Royalty must sit out of competition for one year. They will be eligible to run again the next year. If in the case that there are no contestants running for the title of their age category, the pageant coordinator may ask them to run in the upcoming pageant.
