REMOTE | COMPLETE BY JUNE 21, 2026

- After completing the BSP Curriculum, you'll take your BSP exam online at your own pace.
- 100 questions, open book; 70% score is required to pass.
- Self study for this exam on your own time
- **Passing this exam is required to move onto the BA-T Training.**

Building Analyst Technician (BA-T) Training

IN-PERSON, LOCATION TBA | JUNE 22-25, 2026, 8:30-5 PM, EACH DAY

- 4-day, in-person training that combines classroom-style instruction with hands-on field work.
- Training includes use of industry-standard diagnostic equipment (blower doors, infrared cameras, combustion analyzers, etc.) and best practices for energy auditing and safety testing.
- Field component takes place at an unoccupied home to provide real-world practice.
- Training content directly prepares you for the BA-T exam.

- 3-4 hour comprehensive exam covering both classroom knowledge and hands-on field testing.
- **Scheduled individually within the date range above.**
- Results typically available within 2-3 weeks.
