Introduction

The Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe (Contracting Party) is seeking design proposals from PGST Tribal Members for a logo to be used for PGST voter registration, civic engagement events, and related accessories. This logo will likely be used in “I Voted” stickers, clothing, and posters. Designs should relate to the culture, history, and/or landscape of the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe and the surrounding area. Inclusion of voting specific imagery or related symbols is encouraged. If you decide to include written language in the logo design, use of the S'Klallam phrase “ʔələʔkt cn” (“I voted for someone; I elected someone”) is requested. The chosen artist will receive compensation of \$500.

Timeline

April 28, 2026: Call posted

June 1, 2026: Artist submissions *due*

June 5, 2026: Artist selection notification (this date may vary slightly due to review process scheduling)

Submission Guidelines/Requirements

- Artists must PGST Enrolled.
- Artwork submitted must not currently appear (nor have been previously used).
- The chosen artist(s) will receive compensation of \$500 and must grant full rights to the artwork.
- No more than three distinct colors should be used (not including black).
